

Event Conditions

ORGANISER

1. These Event Conditions apply to the Father's Day Clay Plaque Workshop, where children can create a free clay plaque keepsake ("Event"), provided by Gasworks Plaza, Dexus Shopping Centre (ABN 13001595955) of 76 Skyring Terrace, Newstead QLD 4006 in conjunction with The Market Folk, (ABN 19655950039) "The Partner".
2. Entry and participation in the Event is subject to these Event Conditions.

ELIGIBILITY

3. This Event is for children between the ages of 4 and 17 who are at Gasworks Plaza on the day of the event and register a spot at the workshop activation site.
4. All participants under the age of 18 must receive permission from a parent/guardian to participate and must be accompanied and supervised by a parent/guardian during the Event. Children cannot attend the event if they are not accompanied by a parent/guardian.
5. Adults cannot attend the Event if they are unaccompanied by a child.

EVENT PERIOD AND LOCATION

6. The Event will be conducted within the Gasometer, an open-air precinct located adjacent to Gasworks Plaza, Newstead ("Event Location").
7. The Event will take place on Saturday 29 August 2026 between 9:00am – 1:00pm AEST.
8. A maximum of 96 child participants may attend the Event across all sessions. This capacity excludes accompanying parents/ guardians.
9. Event sessions will run at the following times:

EVENT REGISTRATION

10. You must be a parent/guardian aged 18 or over to register a child/ children for the Event.
11. It is free to participate in the Event.
12. The Event is open to all children who are between the ages of 4 and 17 who are visiting the centre. The event registration will be open between 8:30am and 12:30 pm for walk-in registrations.
13. There is a maximum number of 24 places available for each session. Accompanying parents/guardians are required for supervision purposes and are not included in this participation limit.
14. Spots are limited and subject to availability on a first-served basis. Registration is available on a walk-in basis only and participation is subject to session capacity limits.
15. The Organiser or The Partner may collect parent or guardian details on the day of the Event for emergency management and operational purposes. Any personal information collection in connection with the Event will be handled in accordance with Dexus' Privacy Policy available at <https://www.dexus.com/general/privacy-policy.html>

TICKET INCLUSIONS

17. Each registration to the Event includes the following:
 - a. Clay making set
 - b. Finished clay plaque for each participant to take home
18. All Event staff that interact with children at the Event will hold a valid Working with Children Check.

RULES OF ENTRY

19. You must arrive at the Event Location 15 minutes before each session time and register at the child/children registration desk located inside the Gasometer upon arrival.
20. A grace period of 10 minutes after the scheduled start time will be allowed for late arrivals.
21. You, and individuals attending under your booking (including children and companions), must:
 - a. comply with all reasonable instructions provided by Event staff and authorised personnel associated with the Event including representatives of the Organiser and Event Partner;
 - b. Alcohol consumption and smoking are not permitted within the Event location;
 - c. Children who are unwell or displaying symptoms of illness should not attend the Event
 - d. Any behaviour that is disruptive, unsafe or inappropriate may result in removal from the Event;
 - e. Parents/guardians are responsible for the supervision, behaviour and safety of their children at all times during the Event;
 - f. The Organiser will take reasonable steps to provide a safe environment but is not responsible for any accidents, injuries or loss or theft of personal belongings;
 - g. Participants must follow all directions given by Event staff, the Organiser and/or the Partner
22. All participants under the age of 18 must be always supervised and accompanied by a parent/guardian.

23. Parents/guardians are responsible for notifying Event staff of any allergies, medical conditions, accessibility requirements or additional support needs relevant to their child's participation in the Event.
24. Parents/guardians acknowledge that participation in the Event involves the use of clay and craft materials and acknowledge the ordinary risks associated with such activities.
25. You, and any individuals attending under your booking (including children and companions) must not:
 - a. engage in any conduct that may jeopardise the proper conduct of the Event or the health and safety of staff or participants;
 - b. engage in any conduct that may result in physical damage at the Event Location;
 - c. act in a disruptive, annoying, threatening, abusive or harassing manner, or any other manner that is otherwise inappropriate;
 - d. do anything that may diminish the good name or reputation of the Organiser or Event Partner or any of its/their respective related entities or of the agencies or companies associated with this Event; or
 - e. breach any laws.
26. If you or any individuals attending under your booking (including children and companions) act in the above manner or otherwise materially breach these Event Conditions, you and those individuals may be refused entry or asked to leave the Event Location and be restricted from participating in the Event, in the Organiser's (or its authorised personnel's) reasonable discretion.

COLLECTION AND USE OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

27. In order to manage your booking, communicate with you about this Event and conduct this Event, the Organiser or Event Partner may collect personal information about each participant and may, for this purpose, provide such information to third parties, including the Organiser's or Partner's contractors and agents for the sole purpose of conducting the Event. Participation in the Event is conditional on providing this personal information.
28. The Organiser may use your personal information for such other purposes as set out in the Dexu Group Privacy Policy, which is available at www.dexu.com/who-we-are/privacy-policy. The Dexu Group Privacy Policy also contains information about how participants may access, update or correct their personal information and how participants may make a complaint about how the Organiser handles your personal information and how those complaints will be dealt with. Unless otherwise indicated by the Organiser, the Organiser may provide personal information to entities outside of Australia, for storage and processing only.
29. If your personal information is collected by the Event Partner, it will be handled, disclosed and otherwise used in accordance with their respective privacy policy, which is available at <https://themarketfolk.com.au/policies/privacy-policy>. The Organiser is not responsible for the collection, use, storage, or security of your personal information where you provide such information to the Event Partner. It is your responsibility to review the relevant Partner's privacy policy to ensure you are comfortable with how that Partner will use and protect your personal information.
30. You agree that, by attending the Event:
 - a. you and any individuals attending the Event (including any children and companions) may be photographed and/or filmed by the Organiser's or Partner's authorised personnel;

- b. the images and/or film may be used for future promotional and marketing purposes by the Organiser or Partner with no remuneration;
- c. If you do not consent to your or your child/children being photographed or filmed, you must notify Event staff upon arrival and the Organiser will take reasonable steps to accommodate your request; and
- d. you must not photograph or film other participants at the Event without first obtaining their express consent.

GENERAL

- 31. By attending the Event, you accept these Event Conditions, forming an agreement between you and the Organiser (each, a "Party"). If you are making a booking for any minors (being participants under the age of 18), you accept these Event Conditions both on your own behalf and on behalf of the minor/s, as applicable.
- 32. The Partner is a third party which is separate from the Organiser. The Organiser is not responsible for the conduct of the Partner or any other third parties that are otherwise associated with the Event.

CHANGES TO THE EVENT

- 33. The Event is held within an open-air precinct and may be impacted by weather conditions.
- 34. The Organiser may make changes to Event (that do not substantially vary the event).
- 35. The Organiser may reschedule or delay the Event if it determines it is reasonably necessary to do so upon written notice to you.
- 36. If the Event is interfered with or is not capable of being conducted as reasonably anticipated due to events or reasons beyond the reasonable control of the Organiser (for example, due to security or operational reasons, weather conditions, government directives, a pandemic, public health orders and the like), the Organiser may terminate, suspend or cancel the Event in its reasonable discretion, and if practicable, provide you with reasonable notice, in which event, you will not be entitled to a refund of any amount paid for tickets to the Event (if applicable). If the Event is terminated, suspended or cancelled for any other reason by the Organiser, the Organiser will share a notice on the Gasworks Plaza social media channels for a rescheduled date and time for the event.

LIABILITY

- 37. You may have consumer rights under statute including under the Australian Consumer Law ("ACL") in the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010* (Cth), which may be applicable to the supply of goods or services by us in relation to this Event and cannot be excluded or restricted ("Non-Excludable Guarantees"). Nothing in these Event Conditions excludes or restricts the Non-Excludable Guarantees. See www.accc.gov.au for more information about those rights.
- 38. To the extent permitted by law, if the Organiser's or Partner supply of goods or services in connection with the Event or under these Event Conditions is within the meaning prescribed under the ACL then the Organiser's or Partner liability as applicable for any failure to comply with a statutory guarantee, condition or warranty that cannot be excluded under statute is limited to (at the Organiser's or Partner's choice:
 - a. in the case of services; the cost of supplying the services again or payment of the cost of having the services supplied again; and

- b. in the case of goods; the cost of replacing the goods, supplying equivalent goods or having the goods repaired, or payment of the cost of replacing the goods, supplying equivalent goods or having the goods repaired.
39. Subject to paragraphs 30 and 31, neither Party will be liable to the other for consequential, indirect, special, incidental, exemplary or economic damage or loss (including loss of use, loss of revenue, loss of profit, business interruption, costs of procurement of substitution of goods, technology or services or loss of information) arising from a breach of these Event Conditions (including any claim in negligence, equity or otherwise).
40. Except for any liability which under statute, including under the Non-Excludable Guarantees, cannot be excluded (in which case that liability is limited to the greatest extent allowed by law), each Party's total liability to the other Party for any loss, liability or damage suffered by that other Party in connection with the Event or these Event Conditions (including under statute, in contract, negligence, or otherwise) is limited to \$1,000, and will be reduced by the extent (if any) to which the other Party causes or contributes to that loss, liability or damage.
41. All references to the Organiser and Partner in paragraphs 30 – 33 inclusive are references to the Organiser and Partner respectively, and to their respective 'related entities' as defined under the *Corporations Act 2001* (Cth) 'related companies' as defined under the *Companies Act 1993* where relevant.

MISCELLANEOUS

42. In these Event Conditions, "including" is not a word of limitation.
43. The Organiser may assign, novate or otherwise deal with any of its rights or obligations under these Event Conditions without obtaining your consent, if to do so will be unlikely to cause any material detriment to you.
44. If any provision of these Event Conditions is unlawful or unenforceable, the remaining provisions will continue in full force and effect.
45. The Event Conditions are governed by the laws of Queensland, Australia and the parties irrevocably submit to the jurisdiction of the courts having jurisdiction in Queensland, Australia.
